Snow Pavement Rose

Rosa "Snow Pavement"

Description:

This Pavement series rose has fragrant double white flowers blushed pink in early summer, repeat-blooming; compact, mounded habit, tough and disease-resistant, ideal for lining a driveway or sidewalk; all roses need full sun and well-drained soil

Ornamental Features:

Snow Pavement Rose is covered in stunning fragrant white flowers with shell pink overtones and yellow eyes at the ends of the stems from late spring to late summer, which emerge from distinctive pink flower buds. The flowers are excellent for cutting. It has dark green foliage throughout the season. The oval compound leaves turn yellow in fall. The fruits are red hips displayed from mid to late fall.

Landscape Attributes:

Snow Pavement Rose is a multi-stemmed deciduous shrub with an upright spreading habit of growth. Its average texture blends into the landscape, but can be balanced by one or two finer or coarser trees or shrubs for an effective composition.

This is a high maintenance rose that will require regular care and upkeep, and is best pruned in late winter once the threat of extreme cold has passed. Gardeners should be aware of the following characteristic(s) that may warrant special consideration;

- Disease
- Spiny

Snow Pavement Rose is recommended for the following landscape applications;

- General Garden Use
- Mass Planting
- Hedges/Screening

Plant Characteristics:

Snow Pavement Rose will grow to be about 3 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 4 feet. Its foliage tends to remain dense right to the ground, not requiring facer plants in front. It grows at a fast rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 20 years.

This rose should only be grown in full sunlight. It does best in average to evenly moist conditions, but will not tolerate standing water. It is not particular as to soil type or pH, and is able to handle environmental salt. It is highly tolerant of urban pollution and will even thrive in inner city environments.

This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid.
